


Cushion with patchwork technique

 INSTRUCTIONS

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Here, you'll find tips for sewing pretty cushions with the patchwork technique. Go ahead and combine patterned and single-colour fabrics and decorate with matching ribbon. Our 50x70 cm fabric pieces come in many colours and patterns and are excellent for patchwork.



Material:

Ribbon set 304726

Fabric pieces 305061, 305062, 305048

Fabric for back piece 50 cm 304419

Pattern paper 981996

Inner cushion 40x40 cm

Method:

Cut 40x40 cm of the pattern paper. Draw squares based on the sketch dimensions and cut them out.

Place the pieces on the wrong side of the fabric, add 1 cm seam allowance, trace and cut out. Zigzag all edges. Start by sewing the middle pieces together, right side facing right side, then sew the rest of the pieces right side facing right side. Sew on the ribbons as seen in the picture.

If you want to, you can take the cushion case on and off; find tips and instructions in PDF 79638.

Otherwise you can cut out a back piece that measures 42x42 cm using the fabric with item no. 304419.

Sew the back piece to the front piece, right side facing right side, but leave an opening so you can stuff in the inner cushion. Once the inner cushion is in place, sew up the opening.
