

Boost the cosy factor at home: cover your pots with Zpagetti yarn! The yarn is available in many beautiful colours; choose the ones that fit your home.

Abbreviations:

sc = single stitch

ch = chain stitch

dc = double crochet

Large crocheted pot:

Pot size: H: approx. 27 cm, Ø: approx. 24 cm
The width and elasticity of the yarn may vary.

Material:

2 balls Zpagetti yarn, beige 323687

Crochet hook no. 10, 981757

Method: Base round: Crochet 3 ch, join to a ring with a sc. 6 dc around the ring. Try working into the back stitch loop for a fabulous striped effect.

Round 1: 2 dc in each stitch on the previous round = 12 dc.

Round 2: 2 dc in each stitch on the previous round = 24 dc.

Round 3: Increase by 6 stitches evenly distributed throughout the round = 30 dc

Rounds 4-9: Increase by 6 stitches on each round by crocheting two stitches in the same stitch at regular intervals, evenly distributed throughout the circle. See "Tips!" in PDF 78783 for how to make your work even.

Rounds 10-26: *1 dc in each stitch* = 66 dc. Repeat *-* until the work is the same height as the pot.

Crochet the last round through both stitch loops.



Small crocheted pot:

Pot size: H: approx. 13 cm, Ø: approx. 12 cm
The width and elasticity of the yarn may vary.

Material:

1 ball Zpagetti yarn, beige 323687

Crochet hook no. 10, 981757

Method: Base round: Crochet 3 ch, join to a ring with a sc. 6 dc around the ring.

Round 1: 2 dc in each stitch on the previous round = 12 dc.

Round 2: 2 dc in each stitch on the previous round = 24 dc.

Round 3: Increase by 6 stitches evenly distributed throughout the round = 30 dc

Round 4-14: 1 dc in each stitch = 30 dc.
