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Tunisian crochet – soft and lovely!

Join the revitalised Tunisian crocheting trend! The technique is a combination of crocheting and knitting, and the results are thick and soft. Tunisian crochet is fun and easy, and you can create incredibly beautiful things once you've learned the basics.

Note! Use a hook two sizes larger than the hook indicated for the yarn to prevent the work from rolling. Remember to maintain a loose tension on the yarn. Watch the video to see how to begin.

Yarn required, front piece 35x35 cm:

90 g Azteca yarn, green variegated (323365)

You will also need:

Tunisian crochet hook 7 mm (982578)

Optional black cotton fabric (027633),
two 37x37 cm pieces

Optional black zipper (982347), approx. 25 cm

Method:

Cast on 42 chain stitches. Begin crocheting in the 2nd ch from the hook. Crochet simple stitches back and forth until you have a square. Cast off and secure the threads. Make another piece the same way and sew the two together along the edges to form a cushion case. Alternatively, sew one piece to a fabric cushion case. Then sew up the cushion case first, and hand-sew the crocheted piece along the edges last.
