

Christmas tree mat - Frosty Christmas


For one mat with a diameter of 90 cm, you need: 90 cm dark grey hobby felt (305191) 90 cm white hobby felt (025101) Zpagetti yarn, mint green (323797)


Panokitt Allround glue (220593) Plastic spatulas (180120) Trick marker (981969)

Method:

Draw a circle with a 90 cm diameter on the grey felt (mark the centre and measure from there to achieve a perfect circle). Cut it out.

Cut out the snowflake template (the two pieces will be placed together; see image 1). Mark the centre of the white felt. Use a trick marker (self-erasing marker) to trace the template on the felt. Reverse the template and trace it again (see image 2). The dotted lines should not be drawn/cut; they only indicate how to place the pattern pieces. Draw all six snowflake points the same way. Place the template carefully to make sure the last pattern pieces fit together. Cut out the snowflake and place it on the grey circle. Spread glue on the back of the snowflake with a plastic spatula and then attach it to the grey felt. Glue and attach small sections at a time so the glue does not have time to dry. Cut three pieces of Zpagetti yarn, about 4 m each. Make a braid and glue it around the edge of the mat. If you like, secure it with a few stitches at the beginning and end.
