

Round cushion and seat cushion with leather hanger

Round cushion

Diameter 45 cm

You need:

2 fabric pieces of 47x47 cm; we used confetti green (305328) and dark blue solid fabric (304298) 2 fabric pieces for cover buttons, approx. 6x6 cm, such as grey solid fabric (727632) 2 cover buttons Ø 38 mm (569144) Approx. 225 g wadding (800672) Thick sewing thread or cotton yarn for attaching the buttons, such as Nova dark blue (323056) Sewing needle (981687)

Method:

1 cm seam allowance is included in the measurements. Cut out two circles with a diameter of 47 cm. Tip: First mark the centre and then mark the radius from there, which will make it easier to cut out an even circle. If you haven't already, mark the centre on the right side of the fabric circles.

Place the circles right side facing right side and pin along the edge.

Sew almost all the way around, leaving an opening so that you can turn the cushion.

Cut small notches along the edge to prevent the seam from puckering.

Turn the cushion right side out and fill with wadding. Sew up the opening.

Cover the buttons with fabric and attach them to the centre mark on either side of the cushion. Tie the thread to one button, sew through the cushion and secure the other button.

Seat cushion with leather hanger

Size 44x44 cm

You need:

Fabric piece 46x90 cm, we used Morocco blue (305279) and dark blue solid fabric (304298) Fibre felt 20 mm, 44x132 cm (300191) 20 cm leather strap (305250) Hollow rivets Ø 9 mm for thickness 6-9 mm (982491) Thick sewing thread or cotton yarn, such as Nova dark blue (323056) Sewing needle (981687) Hammer

Method:


1 cm seam allowance is included in the fabric dimensions. On the right side of the fabric (46x90 cm), mark where you will sew the decorative stitches later (see image). Fold the fabric piece in half, right side facing right side, and pin along the edges. Sew together along the edges but leave a 30 cm opening on one side. Snip off a portion of the corners and turn right side out.

Cut three pieces of fibre felt to 44x44 cm. Lay them together and place inside the cushion. Make sure the fibre felt is even and reaches the corners.

Sew up the opening.

Sew the decorative stitch by sewing up and down in the cushion at one mark, at intervals of a few millimetres. Pull and tie the ends together on the underside, then cut off the excess yarn. Sew a total of nine decorative stitches the same way. Make a mark on the cushion about 6 cm from the edge, in the middle of one side.

Make holes in the cushion and in both ends of the leather strap using the tool that comes with the hollow rivets. Fold the leather strap around the cushion and attach the rivets with a hammer in this order: through the leather strap/cushion/leather strap.
