

Golden wedding tablescape

GARLAND

To make the garland, fold small doilies/lace paper accordion-style. Tie them to a string with white hearts. Print little love notes on white paper, then punch out your hearts.

SERVIETTE CONE

Make small, flat cones from natural paper (20x20 cm) for the serviettes. Divide them in half to make triangles and decorate along the edges with gold tape. Then fold the small sides in towards the middle to meet, making the paper cone-shaped. Print the bridal couple's monogram on a white sheet of paper and foil it using the MINC foiling machine (instructions included with the machine). Cut out the monogram into a square (4x4 cm) and attach it to a gold square (4.5x4.5 cm). Then attach it to the cone to seal it, and slip a serviette into the cone. First, fold the 2 short sides of the serviette so they meet in the middle.

GLASSES

The glasses are decorated with a small piece of gold tape that adds a special touch. After the party, simply pull off the tape! The names are printed, foiled and then cut out into pennant shapes (about 13x2.5 cm). Foil using the MINC foiling machine. Roll the pennant around the photo on the glass and glue it with a drop of Panokitt Quick glue.

MENU

We made the menus with gold-coloured A65 cards. Cut out rectangles (10x20.5 cm) in gold card and white card (9.5x20 cm) and stick them together with the white one on top; then, attach to the card. Cut a strip of jute and glue it around the front. Then make a monogram using the same method as for the serviette cone; here, we made it a little bigger. Print the menu on white paper and attach inside the cards.

PLACE CARDS

Names are printed in gold on the natural-coloured place cards. Print names on white paper and foil in the MINC foiling machine. Cut them out (3x10 cm) and attach to the place cards. Then attach 1 flower and 2 leaves to each card.

FAVOURS

We clipped a narrow strip of jute to a bag containing a small chocolate biscuit and attached a white heart. Print the hearts with little love notes on them (like the garland) and glue on.
