



Cable-knit cushion



Knit a wonderful cushion in glorious "Love Wool" yarn. You may think the cable looks advanced, but it's just made with purl and knit stitches and really isn't very hard to knit.

Cast 34 st onto 12 mm needles.

Round 1: Purl 13, knit 8, purl 13

Round 2: Knit 13, purl 8, knit 13

Rounds 3, 5 and 7: work round 1

Rounds 4, 6 and 8: work round 2

Now it is time to knit the twist in the cable, which is always done from the right side.

Round 9: Purl 13, transfer the next 4 stitches to a stitch holder and hold them close to you, at the front of the work, and knit the next 4 stitches. Transfer the 4 stitches on the stitch holder back to the left needle and knit these 4, purl 13.

Rounds 10, 12, 14, 16 and 18: work round 2.

Rounds 11, 13, 15 and 17: work round 1.

Round 19: work round 9.

Rounds 20, 22, 24, 26 and 28: work round 2.

Rounds 21, 23, 25 and 27: work round 1.

Rounds 29: work round 9.

Rounds 30, 32, 34, 36 and 38: work round 2.

Rounds 31, 33, 35 and 37: work round 1.

Round 39: work round 9.

Rounds 40, 42, 44, and 46: work round 2.

Rounds 41, 43 and 45: work round 1.

Round 47: Cast off.

To sew the cushion:

- Our knitted piece measures 40x40 cm.
- Cut two pieces of grey fabric to 42x42 cm and sew them together right side facing right side.
- Leave an opening, turn the case and stuff the cushion.
- Sew up the opening and hand-sew the knit square to one side of the cushion.



You need:

2 balls grey melange Love wool (324026)

Pony needles 12 mm (981676)

Grey cotton fabric 2 pieces 42x42cm (727632)

Wadding approx. 225 g (712718)
